

# THE 2 A'S OF INTERVIEW QUESTIONS

## ASK

### How would I succeed in this role?

Understanding this from the beginning ensures that you will hit the ground running.



### What would my day-to-day tasks be?

This demonstrates interest and gives you a better understanding of the role.



### How would you describe the culture here?

This illustrates that it's important to you to find a good cultural fit when deciding on a job.



### What do you like most about your position?

This is where the interviewer will be most honest with you - listen up!

## AVOID

### Asking questions the interviewer already answered.

This makes it seem like you were not paying attention before.



### So what exactly does your company do?

Not knowing this is a huge red flag; do your research before the interview!



### When can I begin using my vacation time?

Everyone needs time away, but planning a new vacation before receiving an official offer is a red flag.



### I don't have any questions.

You can always ask something - even if it's personal. This can be endearing and creates a more personal connection.
